Marketair Introduces AC SpeedStick, HVAC's First WiFi-Based Ductless A/C System Float Switch

Marketair Inc., an Edison, N.J.-based supplier of HVAC/R components and accessories, introduces the AC SpeedStick, the HVAC industry's quickest to install float switch for safeguarding against property damage caused by condensate overflow in mini-split/ductless air handlers.

The AC SpeedStick WS-100 is also the industry's first electronic float switch offering (optional) WiFi-based Internet interconnectivity. The AC SpeedStick senses a condensate drain line blockage and shuts down the system, then (if WiFi is integrated and available) sends a text or email notification to the HVAC service company's cellphone and/or email dispatch for immediate attention.

The patent-pending AC

SpeedStick's optional 24/7 WiFi texting capability gives the installing HVAC company an exclusive alert before competing companies can be "In most cases, the service company can go and vacuum out the condensate drain line blockage from outdoors without entering the residence and return the unit to operation before the customer realizes there is a problem or returns home," said Andrew Olefson, the AC SpeedStick's sales manager. "This creates a windfall for a contractors' repeat business."

The AC SpeedStick, which is UL-listed and compliant with the International Mechanical Code, is the easiest ductless float switch in the industry to install.

What does the RDS do?

Since the advent of A2L (Slightly Flammable) refrigerants, the rule was made that a Refrigerant Detection Sensor (RDS) would have to be installed on the coil to protect the home in case of a leak in the coil. This was kind of blown up (excuse the pun) because the ability of these two new A2L refrigerants to catch fire in the first place is so very remote, but the industry wanted to not take any chances. Forget the fact that these A2L refrigerant units are sometimes put on top of an A3(highly flammable) heater like Propane and no detection device is needed if there is a leak on that fuel... hummmm?

The RDS's job, in case of a leak in the evaporator coil is to shut off the outdoor unit (to stop pumping refrigerant to the leak), turn on the blower of the indoor unit (to dilute the refrigerant with large volumes of air). Thinking is to minimize the pooling of refrigerant, to reduce the chance of ignition.

As a first step, this is a good thought process. Now let's look at it another way. If the leak happens in the evaporator, whether the condenser is running or not, the leak will continue to leak until there is no more refrigerant in the system. If that is the case, and a heat strip, or gas heater came on, it could potentially ignite the refrigerant that is leaking out. So... If a manufacturer of a coil just shuts off the condenser there is a possibility it could still ignite. Other things that now must be considered... Will the potential ignition source (heater) get hot enough to ignite the refrigerant if it came on in the presence of a leak? Well, if the coil manufacturer is the same manufacturer as the heater, then they have an engineering dept to check their products and say yes or no. If yes, then the heater must be disconnected when the RDS senses a leak too. If it doesn't get hot enough, then the AC is all that needs to be turned off.

If the coil is not of the same manufacturer as the heater, then no one knows if the heater that is near the leak will get hot enough to ignite the refrigerant and therefore the heater MUST be disconnected from operation if the sensor detects a leak.

Let's make this a little more complicated... If the system is a zone system (dampers that open and close By Rick Kincel

automatically) and a leak is detected by the RDS, all zones need to be opened up to allow the air and diluted refrigerant to go through all ducts in the home and not to just one confined space. Again, if this is not programmed into a Manufacturer MATCHED A2L system, then the RDS from the coil must be smart enough to turn these dampers on, and open when the RDS trips and more importantly, it is the job of the HVAC installer to know how to wire all of these potential ignition sources and dampers to the RDS and make the system safe.

Are all RDS sensors the same? Well, that would be too easy... in fact they are very manufacturer specific. Additionally, they are sometimes refrigerant specific, coil size specific, and may have different switching options as well.

So, if we are honest, if ease of installation, safety protection, and engineering of the A2L refrigerants is important to you, then it may be best to use the same manufacturer of all the components in your system in case of an issue down the road.

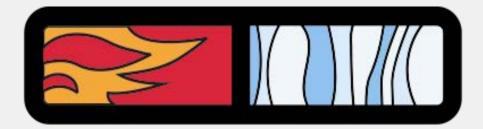

It's On My Heart: The Industry Today

I just heard a report today that Austin Tx has legislation in place requiring all residential properties to have working air conditioning, effective date was July 2025. It was interesting to also see that Austin had one of the first residential projects done in 1954 that featured central air conditioning installed as a standard feature, they were early adaptors.

Landlords are complaining that adding air conditioning to some of the older properties can be expensive, requiring modifications duct and possible electrical upgrades, and now the tax credits have diminished, makes it tougher to add enhancements like central ac. Austin will let you provide window units, and the only requirement is that you keep the temp at 85 degrees or cooler. I did some research, there were 171 deaths in Texas in 2024 from heat related problems, and an additional 281 where heat was a contributing factor, total of 452 just in Texas.

I also read an article from

Service Titan that shared consumer buying traits today. It ties into the two paragraphs above really well. Here are some of the highlights from co-sponsored study, by Visa and Synchrony (a leading finance company). The big news is the size of the home improvement market, specifically for the trades. Estimates show consumers are spending \$1.5 Trillion per year on trades services, we are in the right place today. One study shows that 43% of the equipment installed today is over 10 years old, with 16% installed over 20 years ago.

Angie Snow (Western Air) said the consumer today wants to contact you the way they want to contact you; some may like a phone call,

some will text, many want to book an appointment online, not talk to anyone at all. You have to be flexible, the old way of setting an appointment by the consumer calling your company just won't get traction in today's market. Another point that was made was today there are 3 (or maybe 4 elements) to business. It has to be right for the consumer, for the company, for the community and the employees.

Service Nation does a consumer survey as well, what we found was the female in the home gets involved in major purchase over 80% of the time. So your marketing and advertising needs to be directed to that part of the marketplace. What do women want? Our study showed they value time, money and the well being of the family. So if you can show them savings in time or money and how your products

and services will help improve the family health, it resonates with them. To drive this home, the National Association of Realtors showed that in 2024, first time homebuyers were 24% single women, versus 11% single men. The really important news is that 85% of women who said when they like a brand, they will remain loyal to it.

Synchrony has done extensive research and here are the findings:

Home improvement shoppers shop online 80% of the time and 53% use mobile devices throughout the purchase path. They are looking for efficiency, the ability to research products services, clear and and reviews and transparent financing information. Your online presence must be able to be where they are.

And how about credit cards? Here are the facts.

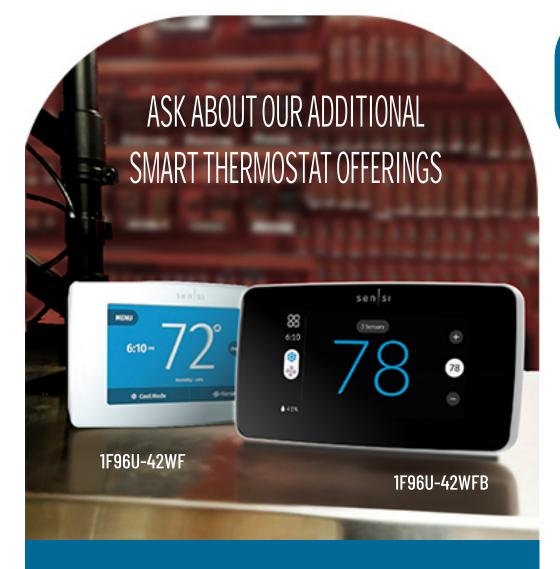

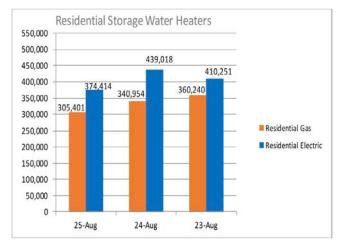

Residential electric storage water heater shipments decreased 14.7 percent in August 2025 to 374,414 units, compared to 439,018 units shipped in August 2024.



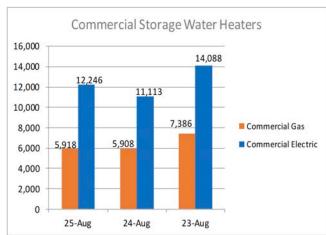
Year-to-date U.S. shipments of residential gas storage water heaters decreased 0.3 percent, to 2,855,704, compared to 2,863,496 shipped during that same period in 2024. Residential electric storage water heater shipments decreased 2.1 percent year-to-date, to 3,409,770 units, compared to 3,484,264 shipped during the same period in 2024.

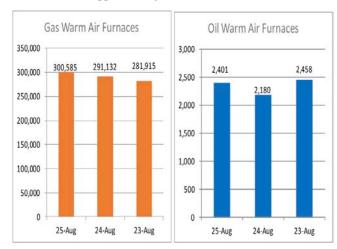

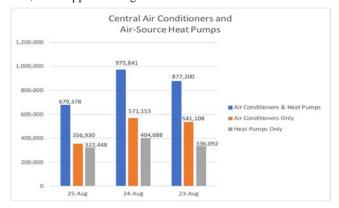

Central Air Conditioners and Air-Source Heat Pumps

U.S. shipments of central air conditioners and air-source heat pumps totaled 679,378 units in August 2025, decreased 30.4 percent compared to 975,841 units shipped in August 2024. U.S. shipments of air conditioners decreased 37.5 percent, to 356,930 units, compared to 571,153 units shipped in August 2024. U.S. shipments of air-source heat pumps decreased 20.3 percent, to 322,448 units, compared to 404,688 shipped in August 2024.



Year-to-date combined shipments of central air conditioners and air-source heat pumps decreased 10.6 percent, to 6,019,962, compared to 6,735,792 units shipped during the same period in 2024. Year-to-date shipments of central air conditioners decreased 16.3 percent, to 3,268,714 units, compared to 3,903,730 units shipped during the same period in 2024. The year-to-date total for heat pump shipments decreased 2.9 percent, to 2,751,248, compared to 2,832,062 units shipped during the same period in 2024.

HARDI Distributors Report 0.5% Revenue Decrease in August

Columbus, OH-Heating, Air-conditioning & Refrigeration Distributors International (HARDI) released its monthly TRENDS report, showing sales by HARDI distributors declined by 0.5% during August 2025.

The annual sales growth for the 12 months through August 2025 is an increase of 4.2%.



"We attribute the sales decline to cooling degree days being off by 10% and August 2025 had one less billing day than last year," said Brian Loftus, Macroeconomic and Residential Market Analyst at HARDI. "We estimate the sales growth was more than 4% with the same number of billing days."

The monthly sales survey also calculates distributor's Days Sales Outstanding which is a measure of how quickly customers pay their bills. "The DSO for August was near 40 days during the first few years post Covid. This year and last the DSO has been a bit quicker at 37 days. We hope this means the customers are financially fit so paying their bills promptly instead of just having extra time on their hands," said Loftus.

The chart illustrates the annual sales growth this year has remained near 4%. "Sales growth has been steady this year despite big declines of cooling degree days in many regions and economic headwinds in all, while navigating the A2L transition. The next challenge of the year is working off the excess inventory during the next few months. After these challenges, next year will be so much easier."

HARDI members do not receive financial compensation in exchange for their monthly sales data and can discontinue their participation without prior notice or penalty. Participation is voluntary, and the depth of market coverage varies from region to region. An independent entity collects and compiles the data that can include products not directly associated with the HVACR industry.

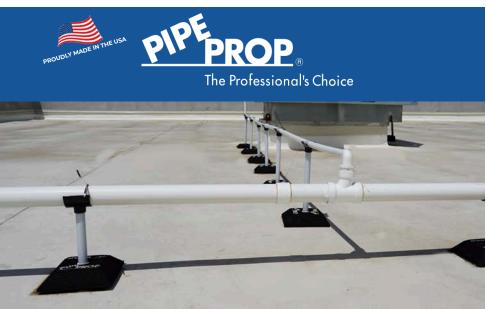

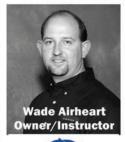

Government shutdown begins: What's next for HVACR contractors

The federal government shut down at 12:01 AM on October 1 after Congress failed to reach a funding agreement. While critical services like Social Security and mail delivery continue, the shutdown will likely disrupt contract payments, tax processing, and other federal services that many HVACR contractors rely on.

In March, Congress narrowly avoided a shutdown by passing a continuing resolution that funded the government through September. This time, lawmakers couldn't reach a similar agreement before the deadline, and the government has now entered its first shutdown since 2018.

How the shutdown affects HVACR contractors

For contractors working on federal projects, a shutdown could disrupt several aspects of your business:

- Contract payments and invoicing will be delayed. Federal payment offices operate with reduced staff during shutdowns, slowing invoice processing and payment timelines. Even fully funded contracts can face delays because fewer staff are available to process paperwork.
- **Project timelines could stall.** If your contract requires federal facility access or oversight from furloughed government personnel, work may need to pause until the shutdown ends.
- Tax return processing will slow. If you haven't received your refund yet or filed for an extension (the deadline without penalties is October 15), expect delays. The IRS maintains limited operations during shutdowns, which means slower refunds and processing of tax-related documents.
- SBA loan approvals are on hold. The Small Business Administration typically stops processing new loan applications during shutdowns, limiting access to working capital.
- Workforce development programs may pause. Federal funding for apprenticeship

programs and workforce training initiatives could face delays.

• Federal rulemaking pauses. Any pending regulatory actions — including those related to energy efficiency programs or equipment standards — will be delayed until the government reopens.

What you should do now

If you have federal contracts or depend on federal services, take these steps to protect your business:

- Contact your contracting officer immediately for guidance on how the shutdown impacts your current or upcoming projects. Each contract may be handled differently based on its funding source and requirements.
- Review your contracts for stop-work clauses and prepare for possible delays in project schedules and payment processing.
- Submit any outstanding invoices as soon as possible to get them into the payment queue before offices become unavailable.
- Communicate with customers about potential delays in federal rebates, tax credits, or other incentive program processing.
- Monitor your cash flow closely and consider whether you need to adjust payment terms with suppliers or access credit lines to manage potential payment delays.

What's next

There's no clear timeline for how long the shutdown will last. ACCA is monitoring the situation closely and will provide updates as negotiations continue. Contractors should prepare for potential disruptions and maintain open communication with customers, suppliers, and contracting officers.

ACCA announces ANSI Public Review for proposed ACCA 5 QI, HVAC Quality Installation Manual

The Air Conditioning Contractors of America Educational Institute (ACCA-EI) Standards Task Team (STT) announces an American National Standards Institute (ANSI) public review period for ACCA 5 QI, HVAC Quality Installation Specification, as a new American National Standard.

The 45-day ANSI public review period started on October 10 with a comment deadline of November 24, 2025. The proposed standard is unchanged from ANSI/ACCA 5 QI – 2015, for the purpose of regaining its ANSI designation as a new standard.

ACCA 5 QI contains minimum requirements for properly designing, installing, testing, and commissioning HVAC installations

for residential and light commercial applications. Developed by a broad coalition of industry stakeholders, the standard identifies consensus requirements associated with quality installations, acceptable procedures for measuring or verifying the attainment of those requirements, and acceptable forms of documentation to show compliance with the requirements.

A public review form for comments with a link to the above standard has been posted on the ACCA website.
